

MINUTES: October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Mayor Nicol opened the meeting in compliance with the Open Public Act and asked for a salute to our flag, followed by a moment of silent prayer, and a roll call.

Councilman Visceglia seconded by Councilman Gorham introduced Resolution 22-86 For Payment of Bills Be I Resolved that the following bills be paid, and that the Mayor or President of Council be authorized to draw orders on the Chief Finance Officer for payment of the bills of October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022, as reviewed by the Finance Committee and as listed on the Resolution and the Computer Bill List amended thereto. Vote: Councilmen Garruzzo, Gorham, Nolan & Visceglia; all ayes. No nays. Passed.

Mayor Nicol then called for committee reports and recognized Councilman Nolan who reminded those assembled that the Harvest Festival and Chili Cook-off would be held on Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at Brielle Park. Turning to the Library Councilman Nolan noted the No Wine or Winers Book Club, Music With Mr. Rob and a host of programs fully detailed on the Library's website.

Councilman Garruzzo cited the success of the Coaster Derby held over the weekend. Although he'd been unable to attend, he understood the turnout was impressive.

Councilman Gorham and Visceglia having no reports, the meeting was opened to the public. There being no public comment the public portion was adjourned on a motion by Councilman Nolan, seconded by Councilman Garruzzo
