

Brielle Recreation Update

At this time, the Brielle Parks and Recreation Commission has decided that the Summer Recreation program for the Summer of 2020 is not feasible with the guidelines set for the by the State of New Jersey. We were advised that the school was not going to be available for us and Brielle Park is not a viable solution. We are committed to the safety of your children and our employees and though we know the children would enjoy the program, the present circumstances lead us to the cancellation of Summer Recreation. We reviewed several options like rotating days, shorter time, 1-4th grade only and other options but at the end of the conversation with the school, Summer Rec Director Caitlin Pinnella and Brielle Council, we believe the right decision was to cancel the program.

As we look ahead, we will continue to monitor the state guidelines and will advise in a timely manner the status of our Flag Football Program and the Brielle Day Dash. At this time, the Coaster Derby for Sept 2020 has been postponed and we will look to bring back in 2021.

This Saturday would have been the North vs South challenge after the hiatus last year to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Brielle, and we are fully committed to this event when the time is right. I cannot think of a better way for the Brielle Community to come together, as we have done so many other times, to help one of our own community members.
